



Objective

Oma-Hold Em is a unique poker variant that blends the structure of Texas Hold 'Em with the strategy of Omaha. Designed to introduce new dynamics and decisions into each hand, this game challenges players to think ahead and adapt as the hand evolves. An optional High/Low split format adds even more complexity and opportunity.

Setup

1. Deck: A standard 52-card deck (no jokers).
2. Players: Best with 2 to 10 players.
3. Blinds: The player to the dealer's left posts the small blind; the next posts the big blind.
4. Betting: Can be played No-Limit, Pot-Limit, or Fixed-Limit.

Gameplay

1. Pre-Flop:
 - Each player is dealt two hole cards.
 - First round of betting begins with the player to the left of the big blind.
2. The Flop:
 - Three community cards are dealt face-up.
 - Second round of betting begins with the first active player left of the dealer.
3. Post-Flop Hole Card:
 - Each player receives a third hole card face-down.
4. The Turn:
 - One additional community card is dealt (the Turn).
 - Third round of betting follows.
5. Post-Turn Hole Card:
 - Each player receives a fourth and final hole card face-down.
6. The River:
 - Final community card is dealt face-up.
 - Final round of betting follows.

OFFICIAL RULES

7. Showdown:

- Players reveal their hands.
- Each player must use exactly two of their four hole cards and exactly three community cards to make the best five-card hand.

Optional High/Low Split

Players can agree to play Oma-Hold Em as a High/Low split game.

- The best high hand and the best qualifying low hand (8 or better) split the pot.
- If no qualifying low hand exists, the high hand wins the full pot.
- Players must still use exactly two hole cards and three community cards for both high and low hands.
